# **Key Vocabulary**

#### **Farm**



A farm is a piece of land used to grow crops and raise animals.

#### Crops



Crops are living plants grown by farmers. Most crops are foods such as grain, vegetables, or fruit.

#### Farm Animals



Farm animals are animals that are raised and kept for agricultural purposes.

#### Farmer



A person who owns or manages a farm.

#### Tractor



A powerful motor vehicle with large rear wheels, used chiefly on farms for hauling equipment and trailers.

#### Dairy



A building or room for the processing, storage, and distribution of milk and milk products.

- UK farms often grow crops such as wheat, barley and vegetables
- UK farms often raise a range of animals such as cows, sheep, chicken, goats and pigs
