Who was Mary Seacole?

Mary Seacole was a **nurse**. Her mother was Jamaican and her father was Scottish. She travelled from Jamaica to look after wounded **soldiers** on the **battlefield** in the **Crimean War**. She set up a **hospital** called the British Hotel to look after **soldiers**.

Who was Florence Nightingale?

Florence Nightingale was a **nurse**. She made **hospitals** cleaner for **patients** and looked after **soldiers** in the **Crimean War**. She set up the Nightingale training School for **nurses** in 1860.

Who is King Charles III?

King Charles III is the current **King** of the **United Kingdom**. He was the longest serving **heir** and the oldest person to ascend the **throne**.

Who was King William I?

King William I was also known as **William the Conqueror**. He was the first **Norman King** of **England**, **reigning** from 1066 to 1087.
