

Forest School

Forest School is a different way of learning outside the classroom. Children are learning from a different approach and are often more motivated by being outdoors. This type of learning gives **ALL** learners the opportunity to achieve and to develop self-esteem and confidence. Forest School is a hands-on experience that takes place in a natural environment with trees.

Key Stage 1

Key Stage 1 children get the opportunity to take part in a half-day session of Forest School on the school grounds with one of our Level 3 qualified instructors.

Key Stage 2

Key Stage 2 children take part in a full day Forest School session off the school grounds at Healey Dell, again with one of our qualified instructors. Here the children work individually or as a group to make various objects/pictures using natural materials.
