Curriculum

At Greet Primary School we follow the National Curriculum. More detail about what is covered in different subject areas will be given by year groups through the curriculum newsletter and during welcome meetings.

Reading

We love reading! Reading regularly is important because it is not only enjoyable but it helps support your focus, memory, empathy and communication skills. We promote reading for pleasure and value the support given from home. Children from Reception to Year 4 will have a reading diary to take home.

Home learning

Year groups will provide information about homework during welcome meetings. You will find out information about spellings, home readers, maths and other ideas for homework projects that will support a love of learning.

Food and drink

All meals are cooked for children on site by our brilliant kitchen team. All key stage 1 children are given a hot lunch for free. If you would like your child in key stage 2 to have a hot meal please speak to the office. Please provide your child with a plastic reusable water bottle with their name on.

E-safety

We regularly discuss e-safety with our children and monitor their use of the internet in school. At the beginning of term we will send home an acceptable use policy for you and your child to sign. Please discuss this at home and talk about the importance of staying safe online.

Uniform

Our school uniform consists of the following:

- School jumpers and cardigans are royal blue. These can either be plain or with the Greet logo.
- Trousers, skirts, dresses, leggings and shorts should be grey only. Children can wear blue gingham dresses in the summer term (optional).
- Socks should be either white, black or grey. Tights should be either black or grey.
- Children should wear either a white polo-neck shirt or a white collared shirt.
- Footwear should only be black school shoes or plain black trainers. No boots. In winter, children can wear boots for the journey, but must change into school footwear when they get to school.
- All religious head wear should be royal blue or white. Headscarves must be fitted for health and safety reasons.
- Jewellery is limited to studs only for health and safety reasons and a simple wristwatch (no smart watches).

PE kits

Children may wear their PE kit to school on PE days. Class teachers will let you know what day your child is doing PE. PE kit must include a white polo shirt or white t-shirt; navy blue, royal blue or black shorts, joggers or leggings and navy blue, royal blue or black sweatshirt, hoody or cardigan.

Medicines

Any prescribed medicine required to be taken during the school day must be brought to the school office. You will need to fill in a medication form giving details of the medicine, time and dose.
