1. Rights of the Child

Mrs Holder talked to the School Council about the UN and reminded the children about when it started and why. The children then spoke about what they remembered about the 41 rights of the child.

The School Council members fed back about which two rights their class had decided were the most important and why. Popular rights among the classes included; 27 (food, clothing and a safe home), 24 (health, water, food, environment), 19 (protection from violence), 12 (respect for children's views), 30 (minority culture, language and religion) and 31 (rest, play, culture, arts.)

A display will now be created in the main hall about the rights of the child using the information gathered by councillors.

The new menu has now been launched. The school council members gave Mrs Holder some initial feedback on how the new menu was going. The children would like to carry out another survey to gain further opinions about the new menu.



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
