


How to access home learning activities on Oak National Academy.

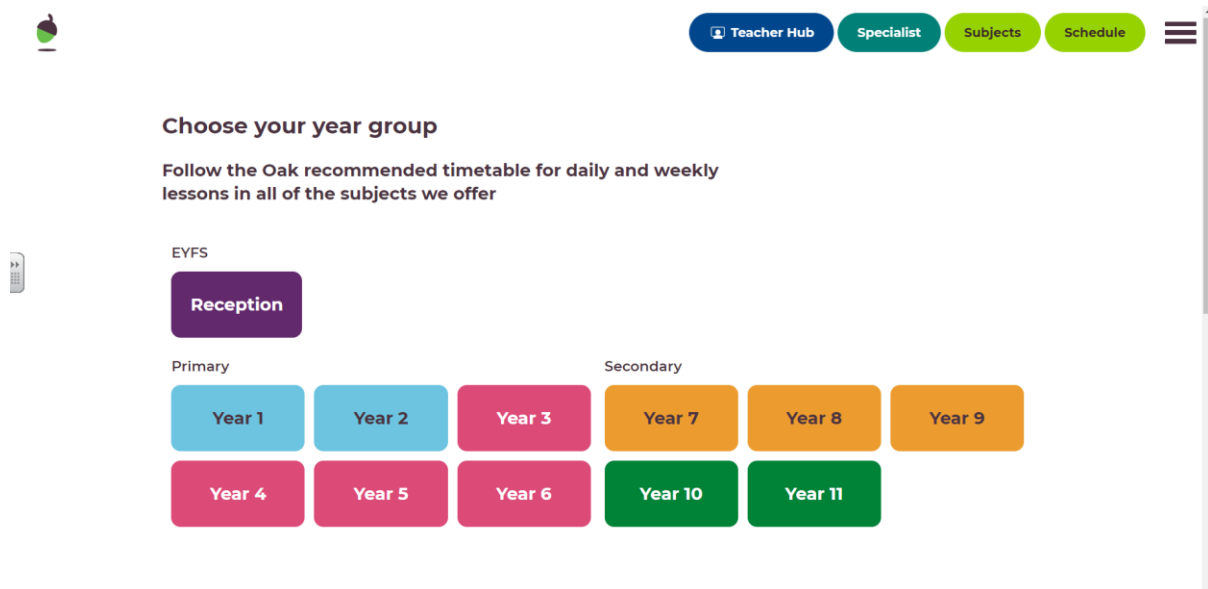
To access the Oak National Academy lessons, please follow the steps below.

- Navigate to the Oak National Academy website on your device. You can do this by typing Oak National Academy into Google or following this link: <https://classroom.thenational.academy/>



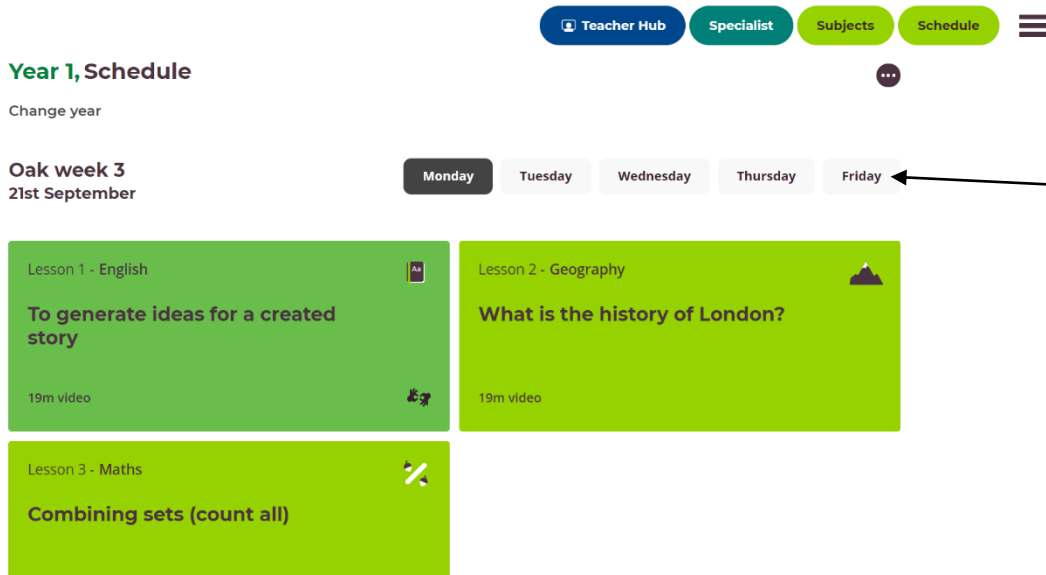

Check that you are clicking on the correct day and completing the work for the most recent week.

You may see work that has been set in previous weeks. Start from the most recent week (the week that you see first). For a challenge, you may choose to see the learning that has been set before.
