As you are aware, safeguarding is of paramount importance to us all. Our staff have a deep understanding of their roles and responsibilities and are fully equipped to safeguard your children. As part of our safeguarding, it is extremely important that we have up to date and accurate information in our academy for you and your child. It is essential that contact telephone numbers are always up to date so that we are able to contact you / your nominated persons in any situation that should arise within the academy day. We also use a text messaging service to relay information to parents / carers so it is vital that we have your correct mobile phone number for this.



Our Before School Club at Grove Academy operates from 7:30am to the start of the academy day, term time and is a cost of just £3 per session.

The After School Club operates from the end of the academy day and is a cost of £6 per session for collection up to 4:00pm and a cost of £9 per session for collection up to 5:45pm, term time. If you require a Before and After School Club place for your child at Grove Academy you are required to complete the Before and After School Club registration form below before you child is eligible to attend. Once a place has been confirmed for your child, please follow the instructions below to book and pay for your child's sessions via ParentPay.
