

## KS2 Outcomes (Attainment & Progress)– July 2018

### Headlines

Below are the key sections of data outcomes from the school year 2017-2018. We were especially pleased with our Key Stage 1 to 2 progress scores which were all above the national average, with Writing and Maths being in the top 25% of schools nationally.
