Happy half term!

I simply cannot thank you enough for your continued support over a very challenging first half term. As a school community we have embraced the 'new normal' very well, children and staff have been exceptional at following our new procedures and have strictly kept within their bubble groups. The vast majority of parents have adhered to our new systems for drop off and collection which has helped greatly, thank you. Our attendance in school is 97% for both pupils and staff which I am sure you will agree is brilliant considering the local and national picture.

I must add however that if a child, parent or sibling has developed symptoms, you as parents have been incredibly pro-active and have kept your child/ren off school until a negative test result has come back and have been very supportive if your child has been sent home with symptoms. These supportive and pro-active measures have had a positive impact in school, thank you. Combined with planned, strict and monitored safety procedures in school and staff/ pupil compliance, I am pleased that we have not sent home any bubbles so far.

Yesterday we had a **Health and Safety Executive Covid-19 spot check inspection**, we are very proud to report that the inspectors applauded the school for our stringent, detailed and thorough safety measures and we were told that we are doing a great job in safeguarding our staff, children and community under very challenging circumstances. The information provided and the walk around the site successfully demonstrated how we are doing this.

We face another tough half term from Monday 2nd November and at some point it is likely we will need to send bubbles home for isolation irrespective of the solid safety procedures we have in place. Please be assured that our remote learning plan is active (please see the website) to ensure your child has an opportunity to learn from home.

Finally, thank you for all the positive feedback during parents evening. 93% of parents had a phone call from the class teacher to discuss their child's progress since September. Everyone has adjusted well to a new way of communicating.

I must extend a special thanks to all of the staff for being so hardworking, committed and diligent, this is especially important in the current climate. Teaching longer sessions limited to bubbles with less breaks and more dinner duties and in some cases covering absence is very difficult. I appreciate and value each and every member of staff both individually and collectively, thank you.

I hope you all have restful half term, we look forward to Autumn 2.
