

Rewind to Year 1

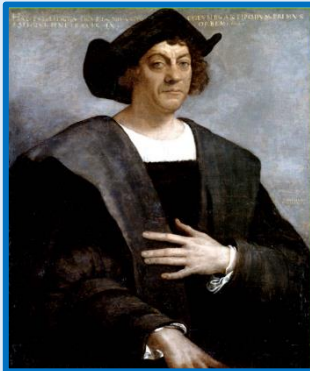


Autumn – Homes in the Past.

Summer – Famous Queens.

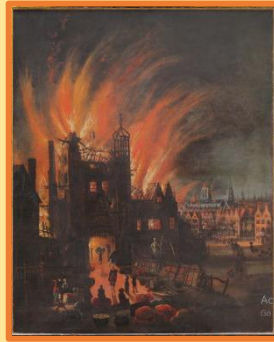
Find answers to simple questions about the past from sources of information e.g. artefacts.

Fast-forward to Year 3

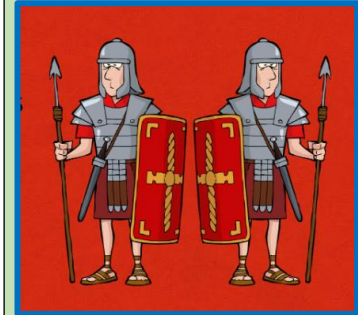


Autumn – Pre- historic World (Stone Age to Iron Age).
