Compare pictures or photographs of people and events in the past.






Autumn — Prehistoric World (Stone Age to Iron Age)

Understand why people may have wanted to do something different.




Gather more detail from sources such as maps to build up a clearer picture of the past.

Explain how people and events in the past have influenced life today.


Fast-forward to Year 4
