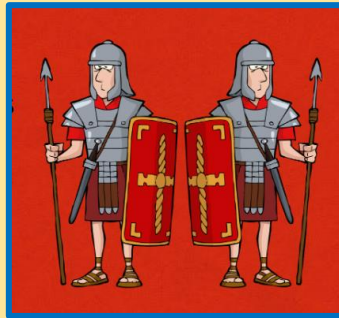


Autumn – Pre- historic World (Stone Age to Iron Age)

of the past.



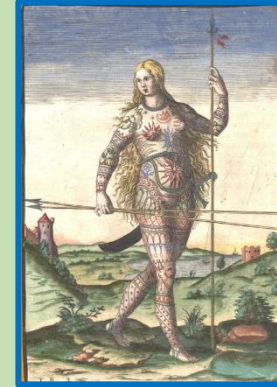
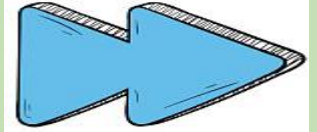
Summer – How do we find out about Ancient Egypt?
