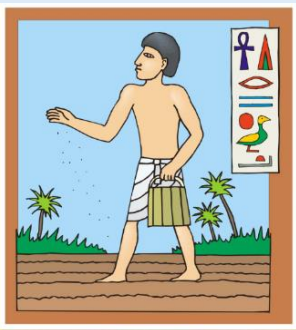
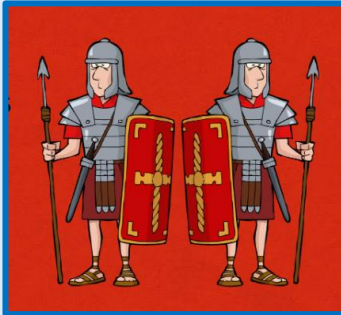


Autumn – Pre-historic World (Stone Age to Iron Age)

Gather more detail from sources such as maps to build up a clearer picture of the past



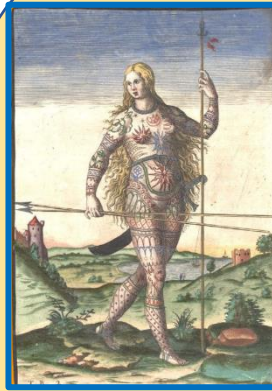
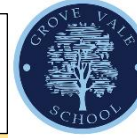
Summer – How do we find out about Ancient Egypt?

Use a range of primary and secondary sources to find out about the past.



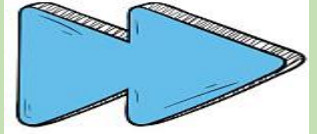
Summer – The Windrush

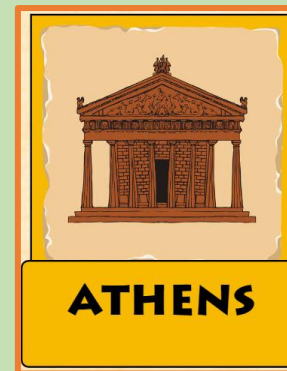


Autumn – Vikings v Anglo-Saxons
