

## Blind Dave visit to school

On Monday, we were very lucky to have been visited by David Heeley. He was in school as part of the Move It Sandwell initiative, which is all about teaching people the importance of being active. David, who is better known as Blind Dave, is a father of three from West Bromwich who was the first blind person to complete the seven marathon challenge in 2008. In late 2016, UK film production company, Pixel Revolution Films announced that they were producing a film titled "7 Days" based on the life of Dave Heeley. The film was released in 2019 and is directed by Ian and Dominic Higgins and produced by Nigel Martin Davey.
