

New School year

Welcome to a new school year! We hope you had a very enjoyable summer and that you and your children are ready for the exciting year ahead. A very special welcome to all the children and families joining Grove Vale Primary School this term. Our new Reception and Pre-School children are starting over the first two weeks.

We had our first 2 reception intakes this week and all the children looked wonderful in their new uniforms and settled in really well. The pre-school staff have been completing home visits ready to welcome the new children at Little Valers in the next couple of weeks. We look forward to getting to know our new pupils and families over the coming weeks.

A Few reminders

- Thank you to all parents for ensuring that all our children have the correct uniform and shoes for the start of the new year adhering to the uniform policy.
- All school uniform, including P.E. kit, coats and shoes must be named.
- PE kits should have been sent into school and should remain in school for the half term just in case PE day changes.
- Please ensure that your child has a water bottle (containing water only) in school every day. Pupils in Juniors are permitted to bring a piece of fruit or a healthy snack for morning break time. No biscuits, sweets or crisps please.
- No dogs or pets apart from guide dogs are allowed onto the school grounds.
- Please ensure emergency contact details are kept updated. If you have changed your home, work or mobile numbers please inform the school office as soon as possible.
- Please take care when parking. Do not park on zigzag lines, corners, the pavement or across neighbours' drives.

Walk to school initiative

As of this term we are promoting children walking to school. Children will complete a daily interactive **WOW Travel Tracker by clicking on an icon that shows how they have travelled to school**. If they travel sustainably (walk, cycle or scoot) once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge.

Attendance and Punctuality

Soft Start—juniors can enter the school from 8.35am and infants from 8.40am. A member of staff will be on the junior gate and a member of staff on the gate in reception and doors from year 1 and 2. The junior gate is locked at 8.45am and infant gate locked at 8.50am. If children are late they need to come through the office.

Please remember that if your child is absent from school you must phone school before 9.30 a.m. to let us know.

School Meals

A reminder that ALL Infant pupils are entitled to a free school meal. There is a charge for all pupils in Juniors. Payments need to be made via Parent Pay. If you think your child may be eligible for free school meals please speak to Mrs Farley in the school office. Menus have been sent home, displayed in the main entrance and school halls.

Medication in School

Please can all parents make sure that all medication (inhalers, epi-pens, medicines). Some medication has been sent home as it is out of date, please send new medication back to school as soon as possible. These medications should stay in school at all time.
