#### Spring Attendance Review

This term's whole school attendance is: 95.93%



Each term, we reward children who have 100% attendance. We are pleased to inform you that this term, 15% of the school (62 children) will receive a silver attendance award certificate—this means they have not missed a day of school all year.

We also award pupils who have 100% attendance for the spring term. 36% of the school (153 pupils) received a certificate. Well done everyone keep it up!

#### Soft Start Launch

In a further attempt to improve punctuality, road safety and to support our parents, we are going to introduce on a trial basis a soft start to our school day. We hope this will go some way to alleviate traffic and ensure our pupils arrive in a timely and safe manner. It is important to note that the register times will remain the same and there is no expectation that children need to attend school earlier. There is however, an opportunity for the children to start the school day 10 minutes earlier. There will be a member of staff on duty in each junior playground and at the doors or reception, year 1 and 2, every day ten minutes before the bell goes – this is 8.35am in the Juniors and 8.40am in the Infants. Children are welcome in classrooms from 8.35am in Juniors and 8.40am in Infants, there will be SO-DA (start of the day activities) for the children to complete until the bell goes. We are trialling this from Easter (Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April) until Friday 24 May. We welcome feedback and will monitor the impact closely before we make a final decision about making the arrangement permanent or reverting back to our current practice.

The winners were chosen on Monday and awarded an Easter egg each.


