Dear Parents / Carers

Remote Learning Plans week commencing 8 March

I hope that this letter finds that you and your families are in good health.

We are very excited to welcome our students back into school in the week commencing 8 March. In order to facilitate this smooth transition, as we have explained in previous letters, students will have staggered starts to their week, as we carry out lateral flow covid testing.

This means that from 8 March our Remote Learning delivery will change:

- Students should revert to their normal school timetables. Normal timetables are the 25 lessons a week, 5 hours a day which students would follow when in school. This timetable has been re-issued to you all via e-mail on Wednesday 3 March.
- We will not be delivering live lessons, but will be uploading lesson activities and tasks at the start of each day as per their original timetables.
- This work will be placed in their original class Team for the students to complete.
- Teachers will check this work for completion on return to school.

We have made these changes so that we can ensure we have adequate staffing for a smooth testing process, and to reflect the staggered nature of the start to school.
