Dear Parent / Carer

Information request

Ahead of school fully reopening, we are writing to ask that you let us know if your child or anyone in your household meets any of the following criteria:

- 1) They have impaired immune defence mechanisms in their bodies (known as immuno-compromised) and hence will be more likely to acquire infections.
- 2) They have impaired immunity caused by certain treatments such as those for leukaemia or other cancers, like cytotoxic therapy and radiotherapy. Other treatments such as high doses of steroids may also have a similar effect.
- 3) They have a rare disease which reduces their ability to fight off infection.
- 4) They are pregnant.

Where you have made us aware that your child or anyone in your household meets any of the criteria above, we will notify you of any occurrences of infectious diseases that we become aware of.

Please note that you are responsible for keeping us informed of any changes to your child's condition or that of someone in your household.

Requirement to notify school

As a reminder, in order to protect vulnerable students and staff in school it is very important that you inform School as soon as you become aware that your child, or any family members/close contacts, have been in contact with and may be a carrier of:

- COVID-19
- Chicken Pox
- Measles
- German Measles
- E-Coli
- Meningitis
