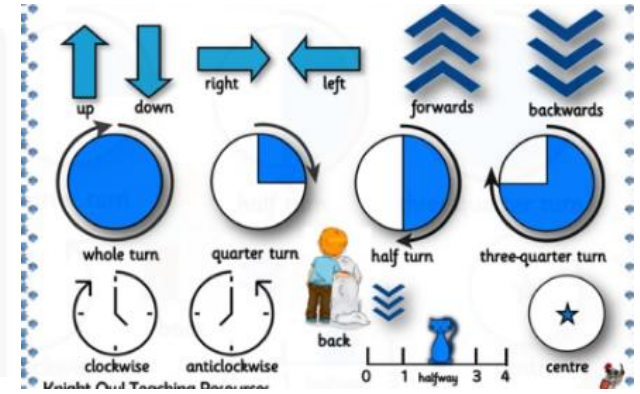
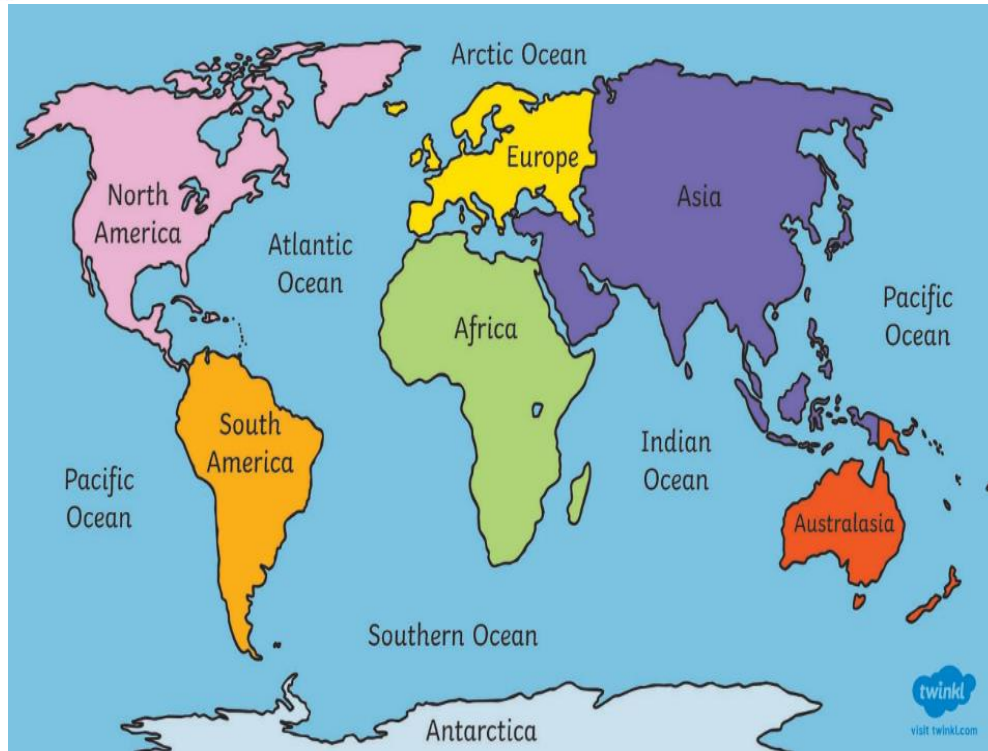

Continent	The way countries are grouped together. Europe, Asia, Africa, North America, South America and Antarctica	Direction	Where someone or something moves to.
Globe	Model of the Earth.	Travel	To go from one place to another
World	The Earth together with all its people and countries.	Transport	Something that takes or carries people or objects from one place to another.
