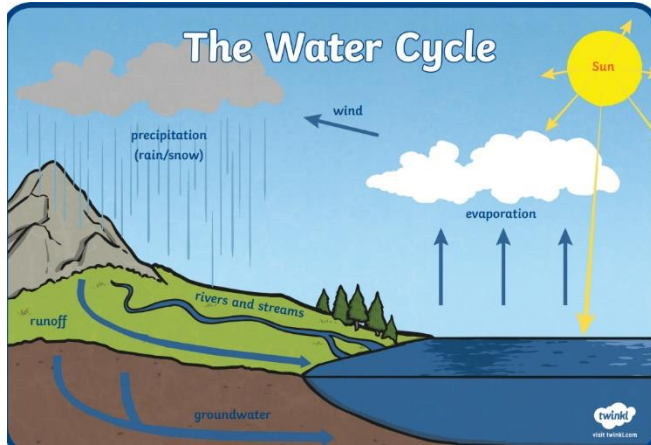




# Year 3 - Summer 2 - The Lake District vs Local Environment

The River Orwell flows through the county of Suffolk in England from Ipswich to Felixstowe.

The River Eden is one of the rivers that flows through the Lake District, Cumbria.

The highest mountain in England is found in the Lake District: Scarfell Pike.
