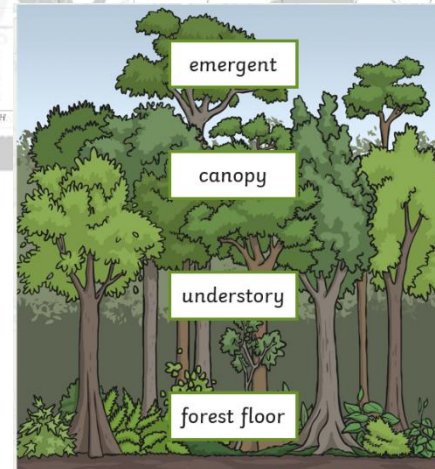
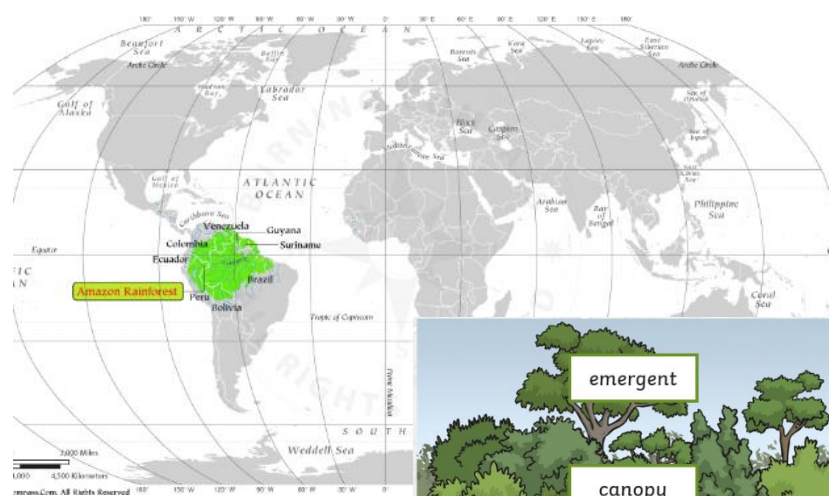




Year 5 - Spring 2 - Amazon Rainforest



Key Facts

At least 80% of the developed world's food originated in the tropical rainforest

The Amazon Rainforest produces more than 20% of the world's oxygen

The Amazon Basin contains 20% of the world's fresh water.

2.5 million insect species, 40 000+ plant species, 3 000 edible fruits and 2 000+ species of birds and mammals live in the Amazon Rainforest.

It has parts in Brazil, Peru, Colombia, Venezuela, Ecuador, Bolivia, Guyana, Suriname and French Guiana
