#### School Attendance Fines

CLEVER NEVER GOES is the new Please note that if your child has more than four days unauthorised absence then both parents will be issued with a £60 fine for each child It may appear a little harsh but our approach has to be clear and unequivocal. Thank you for your support in this matter. From August 2024, the fine for school absences across the country will be £80 if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days. This rate is in line with inflation and is the first increase since 2012. In the case of repeated fines, if a parent receives a second fine for the same child within any three-year period, this will be charged at the higher rate of £160. Fines per parent will be capped to two fines within any three-year period. Once this limit has reached, other action like been а parenting order or prosecution will be considered. All fines go directly to Suffolk County Council and not the


# **Behaviour Chart**


