During his visit, Mr George gave an interactive presentation to the whole school where he answered a range of questions, took part in mindset activities, practiced breathing techniques and more. Then he went around to each classroom to answer more questions, took photographs and signed cards or drawings the children had brought in. Every child received an ActiPH water bottle with a picture of himself on. All the Staff said: "Our children were transfixed by Steel; not just because of his exploits on Gladiators or the fact that he has been crowned the UK's fittest man but because of the message he gave to the children, resilience, be positive, eat healthily, keep hydrated and work hard.

Year 3 Girls' Football Team

Gusford have arranged for children to participate in various workshops to help celebrate STEM week and Friends of Gusford are pleased to be able to fund these exciting workshops.



Reception to Year 2 will take part in Ozobot workshops run by RobotFun. These 'Ozobot Workshops' will give the children a chance to engage in fun and creative coding using a variety of robots



Year 3 to Year 6 will be visited by Prime VR who are bringing VR headsets for the children to use in their workshops. During the workshops the children will travel to different times or places around the world that fit in with their current learning in school





In the STEM workshops run by Prime VR each year group will have a different experience they take part in. To find out more about your childs workshop theme take a look below

YEAR 3 - Discover the Egyptians

Transport pupils back in time so that they can discover this period of ancient history for themselves. Step foot inside a reconstructed tomb and see a whole city brought back to life. We'll also bring your class within touching distance of the Pyramids of Giza!







YEAR 4 - Explore Ancient Maya

Take a virtual trip to Mexico to explore the ancient city of Chichén Itzá, a UNESCO world heritage site and one of the Seven New Wonders of the World. This city thrived between 600 AD and 1200 AD but is now an active archaeological site home to Mayan ruins, temples and even a ball court. Using 360° imagery, PrimeVR is able to show your class key landmarks across the city, including the Temple of Kukulcan, the Temple of the Warriors and El Caracol.











YEAR 5 - Explore the Rainforest

Students follow in the footsteps of David Attenborough by exploring the depths of the Amazon rainforest. Your class will explore each layer of the rainforest and will fly over the emergent layer as well as lurk amongst the creepy crawlies found on the forest floor. Come face to face with leafcutter ants, the Amazonian tarantula, the slow moving sloth, the deadly jaguar and the mischievous capuchin. This amazing workshop is brought to you in partnership with Wild Immersion, an organisation dedicated to raising the awareness of animal conservation.







YEAR 6 - Explore Mount Everest

The class will be transported to see the tallest mountain on Earth, Mount Everest. Students will have the chance to visit base camp, one of the most popular trekking routes in the Himalayas, as well as Gokyo Village, a settlement which lies 4,750m above sea level. VR is a great way of putting mountains into perspective and really helps students to understand scale and landscape.






