
Shakespeare and Atlantic class won this week's class attendance – winning gold tickets for everyone in their class!

Mental Health Awareness Week is taking place between 15th to 21st May 2023 and we know that many schools will find this year's theme of anxiety very pertinent. A study by NHS Digital showed that one in six children aged five to 16 were identified as having a probable mental health problem in July 2021, a huge increase from one in nine in 2017. That's five children in every classroom. The green ribbon is the international symbol of mental health awareness, so we are asking teachers, staff, and pupils to wear green on Thursday 18th May and fundraise for Mental Health Awareness Week. Any money raised will be used to help us fight for the prevention of mental ill health by continuing our research and delivering life-changing programmes throughout the UK.
