<b>Mammals</b>	Animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.	<b>Amphibians</b>	Animals that live in the water as babies and on land as they grow older.
<b>Birds</b>	Animals that have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.	<b>Herbivores</b>	Animals that eat plants.
<b>Fish</b>	Animals that only live in the water.	<b>Carnivores</b>	Animals that eat other animals.
<b>Reptiles</b>	Animals that have scales and lay eggs.	<b>Omnivores</b>	Animals that eat plants and other animals.
