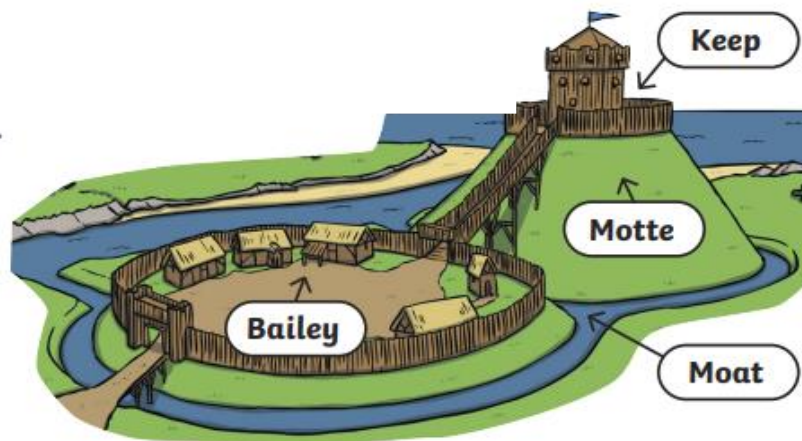
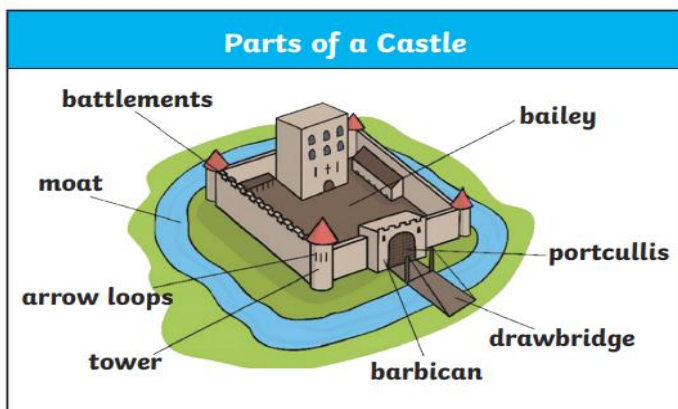
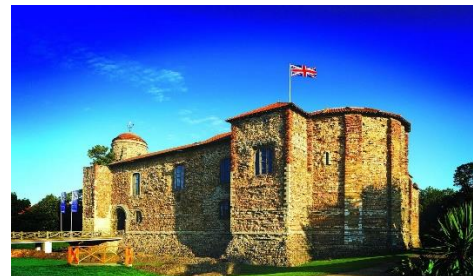

Key Vocabulary

castle	A large, strong building made to protect people inside from attack.	battlements	Found at the top of the castle's walls with openings to shoot arrows through.
arrow loops	A narrow, vertical slit in a castle wall from which arrows are fired.	drawbridge	A bridge which can be raised or lowered to get into the castle and protect it.
motte	A tall steep sided mound on which the keep is built.	tower	A tall, narrow building making part of the castle.
bailey	An area surrounded by a wooden fence in which soldiers and servants lived.	moat	A deep, wide ditch filled with water which surrounds the castle to protect it.
keep	The strongest part built on top of the motte where the owner lived.	portcullis	A strong barrier that can be lowered to block the entrance.
