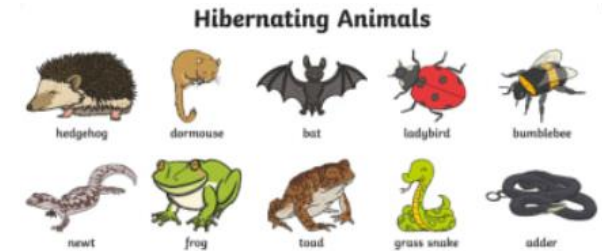
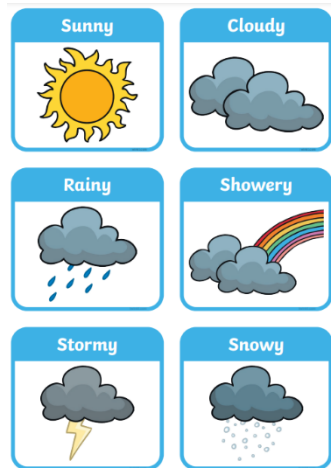




# Year 1 - Autumn 1 - Seasonal Change



## Key Vocabulary

<b>Seasons</b>	The four groups of weather changes. These are called <b>autumn, winter, spring</b> and <b>summer</b> .	<b>Winter solstice</b>	The shortest day of the year - 21 <sup>st</sup> December.
<b>Daylight</b>	This is when it is light outside. The amount of <b>daylight</b> changes with each season.	<b>Weather</b>	What the sky and air are like outside e.g. windy, hot, raining.
<b>Sunrise</b>	The time in the morning when sun first appears.	<b>Temperature</b>	How hot or cold something is.
<b>Sunset</b>	The time in the night time when the sun disappears.	<b>Hibernate</b>	To spend the winter in a special kind of sleep.
<b>Summer solstice</b>	The longest day of the year - 21 <sup>st</sup> June.	<b>Migrate</b>	To move away on a long journey from one place to another.
