Ideas for home

Pre-School/EYFS - Play 'What's the time Mr Wolf?' Talk about the different things we do during different times of the day e.g. morning, night.

Year 1/Year 2 - Make a clock using natural objects then move the hands to make different times. Talk about things you do at different times of the day e.g. morning, afternoon, evening, night. Complete 1 minute challenges. Order days of the week and months of the year.

Year 3/Year 4 - Tell the time at different intervals in the day using different clocks (digital and analogue) then convert to 12h and 24hr times. What can you do in 1 minute challenges, estimate 1 minute, 5 minutes, 10 minutes..., Time how long it takes to jump 100 times, to touch your toes 20 times, to tidy your games away.... Look at recipes and the times they take to make.

Year 5/Year 6 - Create your own time games e.g. bingo, top trumps cards. Tell the time at different parts of the day and convert to 12hr or 24 hr. Look at train or bus timetables and work out the time to get to different places.
