Home Shop

Examples:

Texture Treasure Hunt

Can you find textures which are:

- Rough
- Smooth
- Bumpy
- Patterned

Choose a few different surfaces and make rubbings. Leaves and other natural objects can make a lovely piece of artwork.

The bean game. When an adult calls out a type of bean you must do the following movements...

Runner bean – run on the spot

Jumping bean – jump on the spot

Broad bean – Stretch your arms and legs wide

Baked bean – curl up on floor in a ball

Frozen bean – freeze!

Can you invent your own bean?

Number sense

First there were 9 glasses of juice.

Then 6 were drunk.

How many glasses of juice are there now?



$$9 - 6 = 3$$

Now there are 3 glasses of juice

Can you make up and draw your own maths story for a different subtraction calculation within 10? E.g., There were 10 sheep in the field, 4 sheep escaped. Now there are 6 sheep. $10 - 4 = 6$.
