LKS2 Cycle 1	<p><b>French greetings with puppets</b> Pupils are introduced to French through greetings and simple introductions, developing confidence in listening and speaking.</p>	<p><b>French adjectives of colour, size and shape</b> Children describe objects using adjectives, learning word order differences between French and English.</p>	<p><b>French playground games - numbers and age</b> Pupils learn numbers and how to ask and answer questions about age, forming simple spoken sentences.</p>	<p><b>In a French classroom</b> Children learn classroom vocabulary and instructions, developing understanding of noun gender.</p>	<p><b>Bon appétit !</b> Pupils learn food vocabulary, express opinions and practise simple transactional language.</p>	<p><b>Shopping for French food</b> Children extend number knowledge and apply language creatively through storytelling and performance.</p>
LKS2 Cycle 2	<p><b>This is me</b> Pupils exchange greetings and share personal information with increasing fluency.</p>	<p><b>School days</b> Children describe a school day using articles and school-related vocabulary, comparing life in France and England.</p>	<p><b>Birthday celebrations</b> Pupils use numbers and dates to discuss celebrations and write simple sentences.</p>	<p><b>Colourful creatures</b> Children describe animals using adjectives, applying noun-adjective agreement.</p>	<p><b>Fabulous French food</b> Pupils practise ordering food and making requests in French.</p>	<p><b>Gourmet tour of France</b> Children explore French culture and consolidate previously learned language.</p>
UKS2 Cycle 1	<p><b>Portraits - describing in French</b> Pupils describe people using adjectives with correct agreement.</p>	<p><b>Meet my French family</b> Children learn family vocabulary and express likes and dislikes in spoken and written sentences.</p>	<p><b>Clothes - getting dressed in France</b> Pupils describe clothing and express opinions using articles accurately.</p>	<p><b>French weather</b> Children describe weather and present information orally using numbers and compass points.</p>	<p><b>Exploring the French-speaking world</b> Pupils learn about French-speaking countries and use comparative language.</p>	<p><b>Planning a French holiday</b> Children use present and near-future tenses to discuss travel plans.</p>
UKS2 Cycle 2	<p><b>Verbs in a French week</b> Pupils explore verb patterns, including regular and common irregular verbs.</p>	<p><b>French transport</b> Children describe transport and travel using prepositions and the verb <i>aller</i>.</p>	<p><b>In my French house</b> Pupils describe homes and surroundings using extended sentences.</p>	<p><b>French music celebrations</b> Children express opinions about music and explore French cultural events.</p>	<p><b>Visiting a town in France</b> Pupils describe places, directions and local features.</p>	<p><b>French sport and the Olympics</b> Children discuss sports and international events, consolidating language skills ahead of KS3.</p>
