

Our School's Anti Bullying Policy



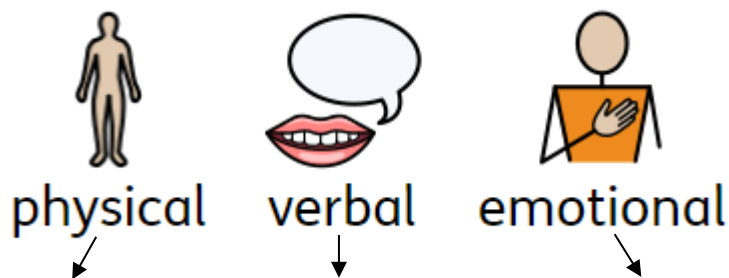

Bullying can make it really hard to learn and feel good at school. It can even make someone feel bad for a long time. This school is a place where everyone should feel good, so we have rules about bullying.

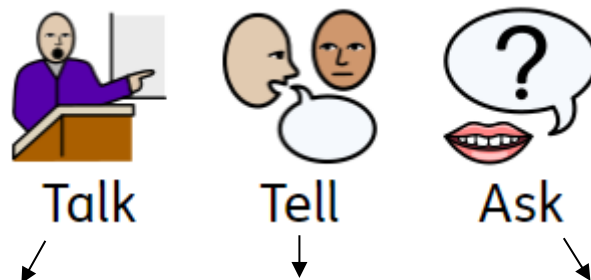
What is bullying?

Bullying is when someone is mean on purpose, over and over. It's unfair because they might be bigger, older, or have more friends. Bullying can be...



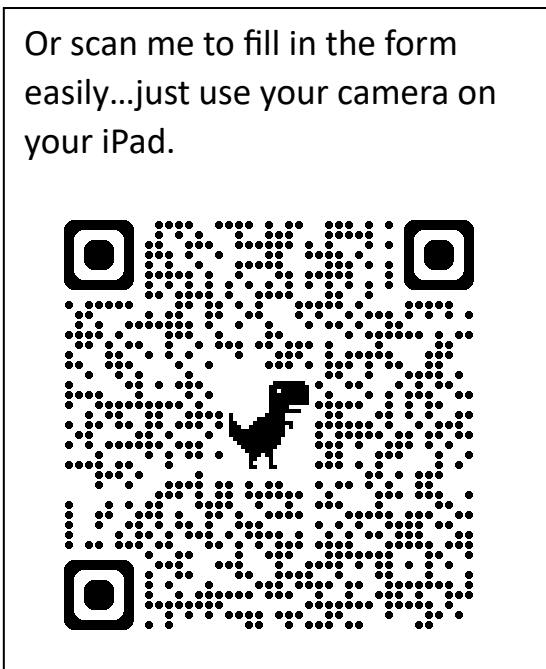
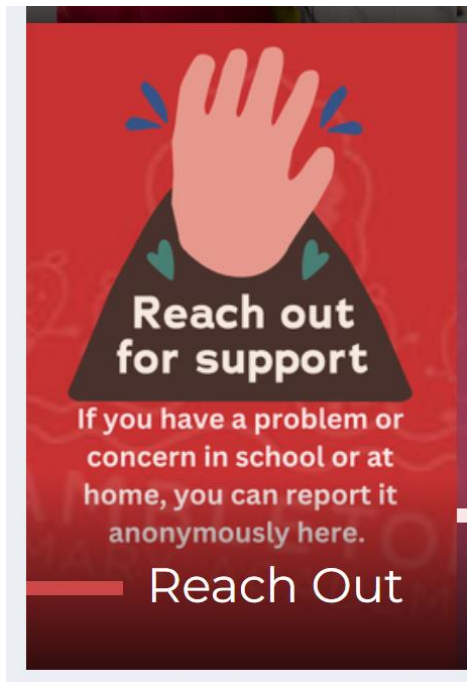
