A key focus for Year Six is preparation for the Key Stage 2 SATs. However, all lessons remain creative, engaging, and challenging. Student progress is regularly monitored by Miss Gray, Mr Goldie and Mrs Wood, Headteacher, and in collaboration with parents, interventions are implemented as needed.

We are committed to an inclusive environment, supporting your child's academic and personal growth both at school and at home.

Homework is distributed every Friday via Google Classroom, with spelling tests conducted the following Friday. We expect children to read daily to enhance their fluency and speed. SATs preparation resources will be available through 'Learning by Questions' beginning in the autumn term. Please note that P.E. is held on Wednesdays and Thursdays, and students must arrive in the full, correct kit on these days.
