


Our topic this half term: *Walk like an Egyptian*

Our book this half term: *Tomb Raiders, The Story of Tutankhamun, Cinderella of the Nile*

<b>English</b>	In English this half term, the children will focus their reading and writing around our class text, Tomb raiders and The Story of Tutankhamun. We will produce various pieces of writing linking to history of the Ancient Egyptians. These will include Non-chronological reports and instructions on how to mummify a tomato.	
<b>Maths</b>	The topics covered this summer term will be; Mass and Capacity, Fractions, Money, Time, Properties of Shapes and Statistics. Throughout these areas we will always be looking to use and apply these skills in real life situations. We will also continue to work on recalling our 3, 4- and 8-times tables, as these are key to both an understanding of Math and confidence in the subject.	
<b>Science</b>	In Science this half term, we will be continuing our investigation into Plants. We will explore the requirements of plant life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil and room to grow) by providing the conditions for germination and recording our findings.	
<b>PSHE/RSE</b>	Our topic this half term will be 'Relationships'. The children will think about what the word 'friend' means and how we make friends, they will learn and understand how to put into practise some of the skills of friendship	
<b>RE</b>	In RE this half term, we will be exploring Hinduism and we will be asking the Key Question: How can Brahman be everywhere and in everything? We will start by describing what a Hindu might believe about one of the Hindu Gods, Brahman and begin to recognise our own opinions about some Hindu beliefs, showing respect to Hindus.	
<b>DT</b>	In DT this half term, the focus will be on cooking and nutrition. The children will be designing a recipe for a savoury tart. They will taste seasonal ingredients, peel and cut safely with a vegetable knife and follow instructions to make their recipe. The children will then test and review dishes suggesting points for improvement.	
<b>PE</b>	This half term, we will be focusing on athletics activities and Dance. In Dance, Children will discuss Iron Man and how he searched for broken parts before they copy movements accurately and work as a team to create a still, connected shape with their bodies.	
<b>French</b>	The class topic will be 'Je peux...' (I can...) and the children will move on from learning nouns to learning ten different verbs for activities they do regularly. By the end of the unit most children will be able to form a short sentence to talk about an activity they do.	
<b>History</b>	In History this half term, we will be investigating the life of the Ancient Egyptians. We will be recognising the importance of Egyptian Gods and Goddesses, mummification, and beliefs. We will evaluate the challenges of building an Egyptian Pyramid and we will be thinking how Ancient Egypt is a concurrent event, exploring our timeline in greater detail.	
<b>Computing</b>	During Summer term 1, the children will be taking a Journey Inside a Computer. Children will recognise basic input and outputs of a laptop and explain the purpose of some of the parts.	
<b>Music</b>	This half term our focus will be composition. The children explore songs and poems about places. They will create accompaniments and sound pictures to reflect sounds in their local environment.	

Our enrichments this half term: *We will be having visitors into school to talk about Ancient Egyptians.*
