Our book this half term: Who Let the Gods Out and Leo and the Gorgon's Curse

<p>English</p>	<p>In English this half term, the children will focus their reading and writing around more myths. Our main focus in writing is to write our very own imaginative set of instructions about owning or capturing a mythical creature. We will also be looking at more poetry this half term. We will produce various pieces of writing, these will include a set of instructions, a report on a mythical creature and a poem. We will be enjoying a range of books alongside this topic.</p>	
<p>Maths</p>	<p>The areas that will be covered this half term are: money, statistics, shape, time, position and direction. Throughout these areas we will always be looking to use and apply these skills in real life situations. We will also continue to times tables as these are key to both an understanding of Math and confidence in the subject as well as consolidating all previous learning.</p>	
<p>Science</p>	<p>In Science this half term, we will continue our work regarding 'Living things and their habitats'. Within this unit, we will be focusing on the habitats that animals live in and discuss their suitability and adaptations to thrive in this.</p>	
<p>PSHE/RSE</p>	<p>This half term, our PSHE topic is 'Changing Me'. We will be focussing on how we are all unique, babies, puberty and understating and accepting how our bodies change and that this is normal.</p>	
<p>RE</p>	<p>In RE, we will be learning all about the religion of Christianity. Our key question is 'Do people need to go to church to show they are Christians?'.</p>	
<p>PE</p>	<p>In PE we will be finishing our work on invasion games. We then will be looking at athletics and also be completing the catching, batting and fielding topic which will feed into our rounders and cricket skills.</p>	
<p>Geography</p>	<p>In Geography this term, we will be looking at the Amazon rainforest. In each of our lessons, we will be asking ourselves 'Why is the rainforest important?'. In our lessons we will look at the layers of the rainforest, the people who live in the Amazon and we will also look at Bob Williamsons Park and how its woodlands is used in data collection.</p>	
<p>French</p>	<p>This half term we will be continuing looking at our classroom and then we will be looking at animals that we may have home and learn to discuss which animals we've got at home and which animals we don't have.</p>	
<p>Music</p>	<p>In Music this half term, we are continuing to work alongside Lancashire's Music Hub. We will be learning more about how to play the African Djembe drums and performing in front of our parents and families.</p>	
<p>Art</p>	<p>As artists this half term, we will be focusing on drawing and sketchbook work. We will be focussing on sculpture in our topic of 'Festival Feasts' this half term, exploring different artists and exploring making sculptures using Modroc.</p>
