English	In our English this half term we will be writing non-chronological reports. We will be discussing dragons, as these are mythical creatures in Norse mythology. We will have plenty of opportunities to explore other text types throughout this unit.	
	<b>Project On a Page Idea:</b> To create a piece of Norse Mythological Art – this can be a drawing, painting, collage, story etc...	
Maths	The areas that will be covered this half term are: fractions, ratio and units of measure. Throughout these areas we will always be looking to use and apply these skills in real life situations.	
Science	In our science this term, we are going to be exploring inheritance and evolution. We will be studying the scientific phenomena of natural selection and the theory of evolution by Charles Darwin.	
	<b>Project On a Page Idea:</b> To research Darwin's theory of evolution and create your own drawings, a fact sheet or poster all about it.	
PSHE/RSE	In our PSHE this half term we will be focussing on the topic 'Celebrating Differences'. We will be discussing what makes us unique and how we celebrate this. We will also be discussing how it is unfair to treat people differently because of their differences. We will be focusing on empathy throughout.	
	<b>Project On a Page Idea:</b> To create a few top trumps cards about your family, looking at their strengths and things they should be proud of.	
RE	In our RE this half term, we will be asking the big question: Is anything eternal? We are focusing on the Christian religion and the theme of salvation. We will be discussing the Christian belief on eternal life and how Christians believe this is achieved.	
PE	In PE this half term, we will be focusing on the skill of dribbling, travelling with different balls/equipment and intercepting at the right time. Additionally, we will be continuing with the skill of balance by looking at weight balances and creating balances when weight or height doesn't match.	
	<b>Project On a Page Idea:</b> To create a gymnastics performance which includes balances, travels and smooth transitions.	
French	In our French this half term, we will be focussing on the topic 'The Weekend'. We will learn new vocabulary to enable us to talk about our hobbies and what we do out of school. We will also continue to learn how to tell the time in French.	



Music	In the first half term in music, we will be looking at 'working together', looking at chants and songs from different countries and using percussion to accompany this. In the second half term, we will start our Brass classes with the Lancashire Music Service.	
	<b>Project On a Page Idea:</b> To find a culturally significant song and perform it using materials at home. This can be a chant or song.	
DT	This half term the children will be fully immersed by having their own DT dedicated week. The unit of work is focused around textiles. We will be, planning, designing and making our own designs using a range of fabrics.	
	<b>Project On a Page Idea:</b> To create a piece of Viking clothing or some form of tool they used to use.	
History	This half term in our history we will be learning all about the Vikings. We will be focusing on how and why the Vikings invaded Britain. We will be looking at time lines, artefacts and discussing cause and effect of the invasion.	
	<b>Project On a Page Idea:</b> To create a time line of the Vikings or to create a Viking long boat with the animal head!
