

Our topic this half term: Transition

Our book this half term: The Boy at the Back of the Class and other texts.

English	<i>In our English this half term we will be reading, writing and exploring a range of genres.</i>	
Maths	<i>The areas that will be covered this half term we will be consolidating the learning we already have covered. Throughout these areas we will always be looking to use and apply these skills in real life situations.</i>	
Science	<i>In our Science this half term we will continue to focus on evolution and inheritance. We will be learning about fossils, DNA and its relation to our ancestors, how things adapt to their surroundings and the theory of evolution.</i>	
PSHE/RSE	<i>In our PSHE this half term we will be continuing to focus on the topic Changing Me. We will be continuing to learn about self-image and self-esteem, changes in our bodies how babies develop and healthy relationships. We will also be discussing transition and preparing the children for secondary school.</i>	
RE	<i>In our RE this half term, we will be asking the big question: Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives? We are focusing on the religion of Islam and the theme of beliefs and moral values.</i>	
PE	<i>This term we are focusing on striking and fielding games. We will be learning to bowl with accuracy, throw using overarm, to strike a ball with a bat and using space effectively in games.</i>	
French	<i>In French this half term, we will be focusing on the topic 'Me in the World'. The children will learn about other French speaking countries around the world, their currencies, flags, cultural celebrations and traditions, with a focus on using all the skills they have learned to understand longer pieces of written French. We will also do transition work in readiness for the children moving onto MFL in KS3.</i>	
Music	<i>In Music this half term, we are going to be continuing to work alongside Lancashire's Music Hub. We will be learning more about how to play the cornet.</i>	
Computing	<i>In computing, we will be exploring the topic 'History of Computers' alongside programming.</i>	
Geography	<i>In Geography, we will be exploring the key question 'What are the changes and issues concerning my local area?'. The children will be developing their own enquiry question to explore, observe, collect data for and evaluate. They will be completing their own project using the geographical knowledge and skills that they have acquired throughout their time at Hambleton.</i>	
Art	<i>As artists this half term, we will be creating within the topic of 'Brave Colour'. We will be exploring the work of artists who use colour and how it can be used in a range of ways depending on the artist's intention.</i>	

Our enrichment this half term: We will be completing field work in Geography to aim to improve our local area.
