English Speaking Board

English Speaking Board is designed to improve communication by developing speaking and listening skills.

We will be introducing 'show and tell' linked to what the children are learning about.

We will also be learning rhymes such as 'Head, shoulders, knees and toes.'

This term we will be learning to:

- Settle in to school
- Develop an understanding of the feelings happy, sad, angry, calm and fearful.
- Demonstrate an understanding of what has been read.
- Spell words by identifying the sounds.
- Recognise numbers and apply our knowledge
- Read simple sentences
- Talk about ourselves and our families
- Talk about seasons, the weather and how they change.

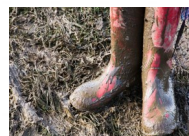
