### This term we will be learning to:

- Write using story language.
- Write simple phrases and sentence that can be read by others.
- Spell some red words.
- Measure, including volume and capacity.
- Numbers to 20.
- Numerical patterns, including doubling halving, sharing, odds and evens.
- Read simple sentences aloud.
- Understand key events in stories.
- Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.
- Looking at the celebration of Eid
- Using texts to look at similarities and differences of life in this country and others.

**English Speaking Board** is designed to improve communication by developing speaking and listening skills. We will be continuing our 'show and tell' linked to what the children are learning about. We will also be learning rhymes such as 'Miss Polly had a Dolly and Zoom, zoom we're going to the moon'.

### Homework:

Summer 1: Go for a summer walk – look for the seasonal changes. Can you record these by taking picture or capturing it in a drawing? What do you notice – how do you know it is summer?

Summer 2: In school this term, we are looking the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears – please have a go at making porridge that is just right for you! Will you add any toppings?
