### Communication and Language:


We are working hard in Nursery to improve communication by developing our speaking and listening skills. We will be continuing to share and learn different action rhymes, stories and songs.

**Summer 1:** We will be learning about and retelling the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle.

**Summer 2:** We will be focusing our learning around the story Billy's Bucket by Kes Grey.

### This term we will be learning to:

Explore mini beasts and lifecycles.

Explore where mini beasts live and make homes for them.

Look for signs of Spring/Summer and go on a bug hunt in the nursery garden.

Be explorers as we investigate our environment and natural surroundings.

Talk about how water keeps us healthy and what we use water for.

Exploring water, e.g. bubbles, puddles
