Dear Parents / Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that we shall be starting our summer term after school clubs week commencing 15th April 2024 until week commencing 24th June 2024.

We would like to thank you for your support and advice regarding the clubs that you would like the school to offer. We are offering the following clubs as extension and enrichment activities for the children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 and there will be a charge of £15 (£1.50 per session, payable in advance).

Clubs begin at the end of the school day and end at 3.55pm. <u>Please ensure that your child is collected promptly at 3.55pm</u> (3.45pm for Bug Club).

If your child would like to take part in any of these clubs, please login to ParentPay to register your interest by 12.00pm on Thursday 14th March, as places will be allocated on a first-come first-serve basis. In the first instance, please register your interest for <u>one club only</u> for your child. **Bug club can be added as an additional club.** Additional places will be offered out, subject to availability. If your child is successful in gaining a place, you will be notified by text message and requested to pay for the club via ParentPay. Full payment of £15 must be received by 9.30am on Tuesday 19th March (£36 for Bug Club).

Please note – children who qualify for Pupil Premium will be eligible for <u>one</u> free club per academic year, as their funding allocation will cover the cost of the club. If your child wishes to attend more than one club per academic year, full payment will be required. In addition, in line with our behaviour policy, the offer of a place for your child may be withdrawn at any time. Withdrawal may be triggered by behaviour, poor attendance or poor punctuality. Should this occur, you will be notified by your child's class teacher.

Bug Club

We are hoping to host an externally provided educational after-school 'Bug Club' for summer term 1. Each week the children will look at a particular exotic mini beast, learn all about their origin, habitat, diet, life cycle and behaviour, whilst getting the chance to handle them. At the end of the club, the children will receive a certificate and a toy bug to take home. The cost of this club will be £36, payable in advance, which will cover the six sessions. Each session will be 45 minutes long and will take place each Thursday, after school.

Please sign up via ParentPay to express your interest and to acknowledge your commitment to your child participating in this club. Payment will be collected from a separate payment item once your child's place is confirmed. Club fees paid will be non-refundable and are applicable to all children participating.
