Sticky Knowledge facts:

- Often structure have a certain function, they are made to do something, eg, chairs are for sitting on.
- A design criterion is a list of points for the product to meet the needs.
- Stable structures are safer because they do not easily topple over or fall down.
- Evaluation is to look at the good and bad points about something to help us improve, and testing a product lets us find out if everything works as it should.
