Fabric	A natural or man-made woven or knitted material that is made from plant fibres, animal fur or synthetic material.
Stencil	A shape that you can draw around.
Template	A stencil which you use to help you raw a shape more easily on to different materials.
Sew	To join or fasten by stitches made using a needle and thread.
Running Stitch	A simple style of sewing in a straight line with no overlap- ping.

'ou will use a variety of techniques to create your puppet including cutting, gluing, stapling and pinning.






When cutting the **template** out, be careful and as **accurate** as possible.



Sticky Knowledge facts:

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- You can combine materials using a variety of techniques such as cutting, gluing, stapling or pinning.
- Materials can also be combined using a running stitch that is neat and evenly spread.
- A running stitch is simple style of sewing in a straight line with no overlapping.
- Decorating makes something look more attractive by putting things on it or around it.
- Designers evaluate their finished products to test if the products works well and to see whether anything could be improved.
- Decorating something makes it look more attractive by putting things on or around it.
