We are pleased to inform you that we shall be starting our Summer Term after school clubs week commencing 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023 until week commencing 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023.

We would like to thank you for your support and advice regarding the clubs that you would like the school to offer. We are offering the following clubs as extension and enrichment activities for the children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and there will be a charge of £15 (£1.50 per session, payable in advance).

Clubs begin at the end of the school day and end at 3.50pm. Please ensure your child is collected promptly at 3.50pm.

If your child would like to take part in any of these clubs, please login to Parent Pay to register your interest by 4.00pm on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March, as places will be allocated on a first-come first-serve basis. In the first instance, please register your interest for **one club only** for your child. Additional places will be offered out, subject to availability. If your child is successful in gaining a place, you will be notified by text message and requested to pay for the club via ParentPay. Full payment of £15 must be received by 9.30am on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March.

Please note – children who qualify for Pupil Premium will be eligible for <u>one</u> free club per academic year, as their funding allocation will cover the cost of the club. If your child wishes to attend more than one club per academic year, full payment will be required. In addition, in line with our behaviour policy, the offer of a place for your child may be withdrawn at any time. Withdrawal may be triggered by behaviour, poor attendance or poor punctuality. Should this occur, you will be notified by your child's class teacher.
