Music


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In our History lessons we will be exploring what toys were like in the past and progressing to comparing them to what toys are like today.



In our Science lessons we will be learning about the human body and identifying the names of different body parts. We will also be talking about the 5 senses and which body part is associated with each sense. We will start to think about working scientifically and answering scientific questions.

In our Computing lessons we will be learning about technology around us. We will identify different types of technology, learn about the different parts of a computer and begin to use a keyboard and mouse.



In Art we will be focusing on our drawing skills to draw spirals. We will experiment with chalk, pencil, oil pastels and pens. We will learn about observational drawing and even take our drawing skills outside!



In our R.E lessons we will be exploring the question 'Is everybody special?'. We will learn what baptism is, how it feels to belong to a group and discuss the story 'The parable of the lost coin'.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be exploring family and relationships. We will look at different families, friendship problems, emotions, stereotypes and working with others.



<u>Maths</u>

During our Maths sessions, we will develop our knowledge through lots of practical and some written tasks.

We will:

- * Learn to estimate and count objects accurately.
- * Recognise and order numerals.
- * Use the terms more, greater, less, fewer and equal correctly.
- *Learn how to use a number line.
- * Add and subtract numbers.
- *Find parts and wholes.
- * Practise number bonds and subtraction facts within 10.



In P.E we will be working on our personal skills. We will begin to understand when to ask for help, follow instructions and start to work on tasks independently. We will also work on our striking and fielding skills.
