# Did you know...

If your child finishes the year with 95% attendance they will still have missed 10 school days, which equates to around 55 hours of learning time? In fact, if your child misses just one day in the week it equates to them missing 20%, with their weekly attendance sitting at just 80%.

#### Year 4

This term, Year 4 have been exploring The Jabberwocky through their Art lessons. The children began by reciting the poem and discussing the meaning of each stanza, focusing on Lewis Carroll's use of imaginative language and nonsense words. Once they had a good understanding of the poem, they planned and created their own illustrated retellings, transforming the verses into a narrative sequence. Through this project, the children developed their comprehension, creativity, and artistic storytelling skills.



Year 5 have been learning about levers and pulleys in science this week. They had to create their own catapult out of lollypop sticks and rubber bands, which would be functional enough to transport a clay character.
