Did you know...

If your child finishes the year with **95% attendance** they will still have missed 10 school days, which equates to around **55 hours of learning time?**In fact, if your child misses just one day in the week it equates to them missing **20%**, with their weekly attendance sitting at just **80%**.

A reminder of timings for all parents and carers:


8.35am: School gates open (both on Salcey and by the All-Weather)8.45am: Children lined up and brought into school – gates shut shortly after
