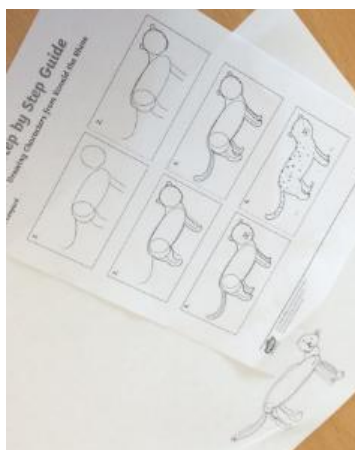


# Year 2 – David Attenborough's 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday!

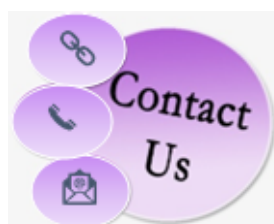
