




Weekly Attendance Figures

Did you know...

If your child finishes the year with 95% attendance they will still have missed 10 school days, which equates to around 55 hours of learning time?

In fact, if your child misses just one day in the week it equates to them missing 20%, with their weekly attendance sitting at just 80%.

D-Day Landings for Hawthorn and Blackthorn

The D-Day landings of 6 June 1944 was the largest seaborne invasion in history. Along with the associated airborne operations, it marked the beginning of the liberation of France and western Europe from the Axis forces and ultimately helped Allies become victorious. Last week commemorated **80 years** since D-Day began, and the Year 5 children learnt about a lesser-known aspect of the event.

On 5-6 June 1944, RAF personnel dropped aluminium foil as a decoy to persuade the Germans that an Allied invasion was imminent. The spoof invasion was executed at the same time as the genuine landings. The overall deception played a major role in the success of the D-Day landings.

Year 5 children took part in the 'tin foil aeroplane challenge' and worked in groups to create and fly foil planes the furthest. They used their engineering skills, as well as their mathematics knowledge, to help them. The design that Joe (Hawthorn) developed travelled the furthest and has been inputted to the online leader-board! Check out our gallery below.
