Annabelle's Sporting Achievements 🏆

We are delighted to celebrate the incredible achievements of Year 5 pupil, Annabelle Baker, who has enjoyed an outstanding competition season in both cheerleading and gymnastics.

During the May half-term break, Annabelle travelled to Barcelona with her club, First Class Athletics, to compete in the Future Cheer European Championships alongside her cheerleading teams, Dreamliners and Mavericks. Both teams delivered spectacular performances against strong international competition and proudly achieved podium finishes.

Dreamliners secured an impressive second place in the Level 1 Under 12s division, while Mavericks were crowned European Champions in the Level 2 Under 12s category. Their exceptional performance also earned them a coveted bid to the prestigious Youth Summit competition, which will take place in Florida in April 2027. Teams can only qualify for this international event by achieving outstanding scores at qualifying competitions, making this an extraordinary accomplishment.

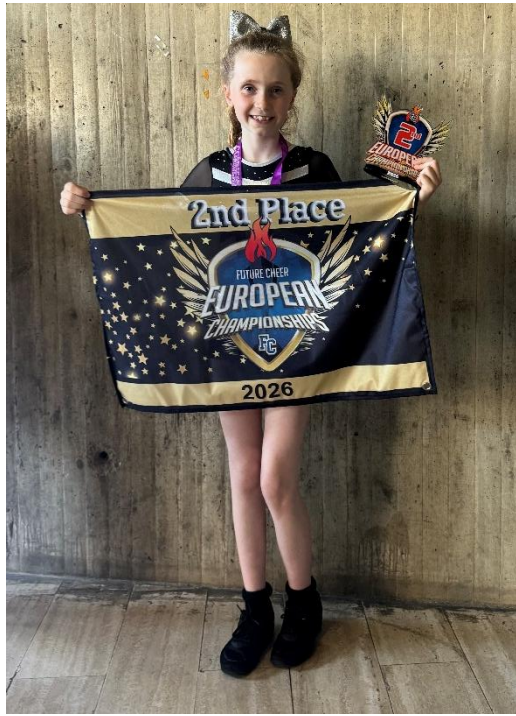
Annabelle, her teammates and coaches dedicated many hours of hard work and practice in preparation for the championships, and their success is a wonderful reward for their commitment and determination.

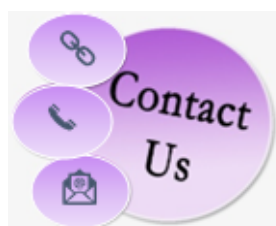
