Writing:

In the first few weeks in the summer term, we shall be looking at a favourite fairy tale and pick apart Little Red Riding Hood. We shall combine writing and grammar to innovate this great story.

For the second half of this half term, we shall be looking at Drew DeWalt's class 'The Day the Crayons Quit'. Children engage with the story massively and they will have the chance to write persuasively and end up writing a letter of complaint.

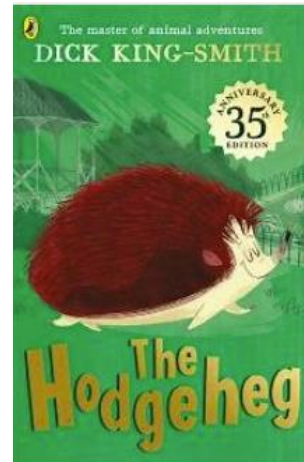
Maths

This half-term, children will be looking at mass, capacity and temperature. They will also be looking at time and tell time to the hour. They will also touch on statistics, working with tables and block diagrams.



Reading

This half term, we shall be regular reading 'The Hodgeheg' by Dick King-Smith. The children will have various books in whole-class guided reading lessons accompanied by various reading comprehensions.



Science

In Science, we shall be exploring plants and giving children the opportunity to plant their own and learn exactly what plants need to survive.

Other learning

Some other things that will be going on this half term, include the children looking at cooking and how they can cut and chop things building on those skills.

We shall also be attempting to compare England and Kenya, using our geographical skills and thinking critically about which one we would prefer to live in. We shall also be looking at music from the British Isles and talking about safe use of money in PSHE.
